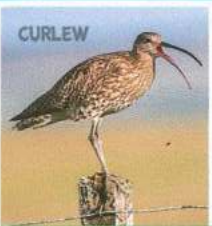

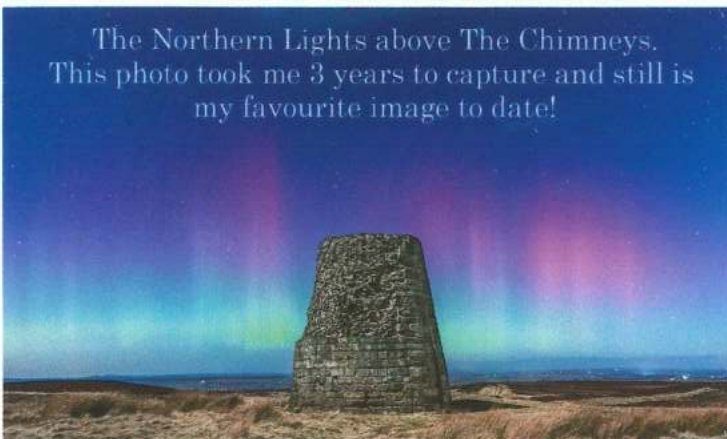

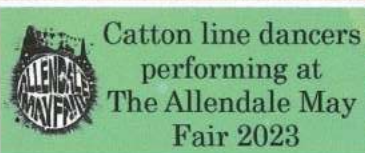


BLACK GROUSE

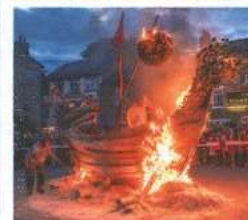

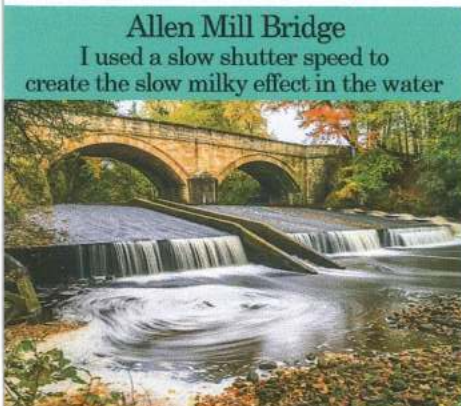

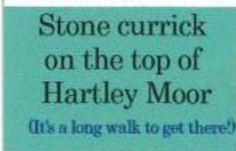

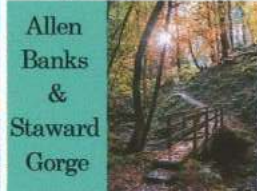

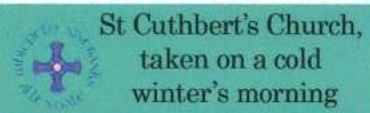

About the Photographer



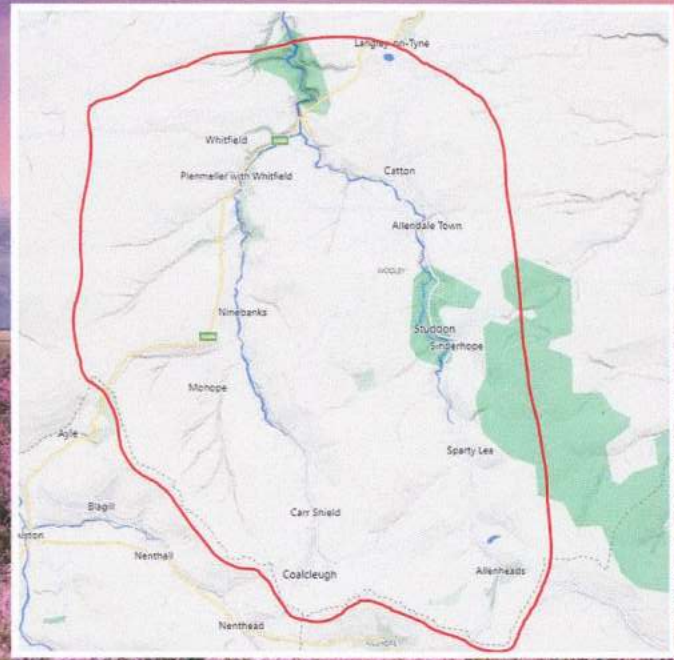
- James Little -

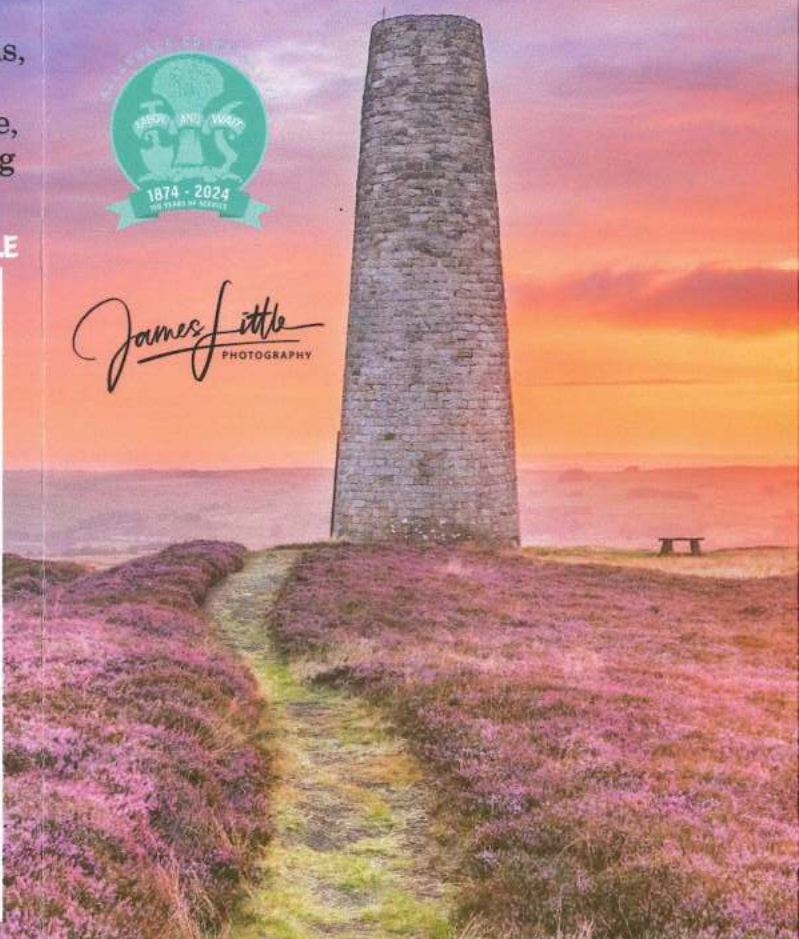
